COMPONENT ONE

Khel Connect Symposium
Building Australia-India SportsEd Excellence

A two-day symposium bringing together leading voices from Australian and Indian higher education institutions, sporting organisations, and government bodies to identify opportunities for collaboration and forge lasting partnerships.

- Day 1: Open plenary on Australia-India sports cooperation, a panel session on the three priority sports specialisations, and a networking session
- Day 2: Working sessions, followed by a structured pitch and matchmaking session and open consortium development time

COMPONENT TWO

Khel Connect Seeding Grants
Seeding Australia-India SportsEd Excellence

A competitive grant program funding Australian-Indian consortia to deliver high-impact, scalable capacity-building projects.

- AUD \$150,000 total grant pool across the three sports specialisations
- Projects in areas such as the co-design of curricula in sports science, high-performance coaching, sports management, and design of integrated athlete support systems
- Six-month funded project period with sustainability and scaling built in from the outset

 Applications open mid-September 2026

 The Symposium will catalyse connections and consortium building, generating the ideas and partnerships that the seeding grants will fund and accelerate.
